## Individual Supplies:

- 2 Boxes of no more than 24 crayons
- 1 Pocket Folder - labeled with name
- 2 Colored Marble Composition books – labeled with name  
(1 blue, 1 yellow)
- 1 Black Marble Composition book (Science Fair-do not label)
- 1 Sturdy zip pouch/pencil case for supplies
- Personal ear buds in a labeled Ziploc bag  
(you may use the ones from last year)
- 1 ruler (12 inch) - for home use
- 1 pack of multiplication flash cards – for home use

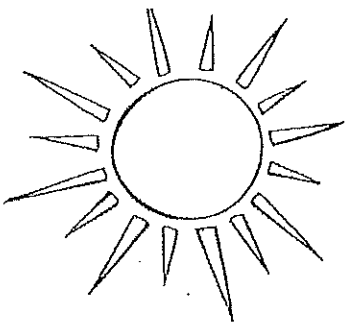
